Frequently Asked Questions!

YOU MUST BE ON SITE NO LATER THAN 30 MINUTES BEFORE YOUR BOOKED TIME BEGINS AND PRESENT A VALID PHYSICAL ID DOCUMENT OTHERWISE IT MAY RESULT IN YOU LOSING YOUR SHOOTING TIME. NO-SHOW WILL BE CHARGED THE FULL PRICE.

Who can try shooting trials?

Everyone who is over 18 years old, sober, not previously prosecuted and holds a Swedish valid, **only physical ID document** can try to shoot.

How long before the shooting do I have to be in place?

You must be on site **no later than 30 minutes before your booked** time begins in order for us to have time for checkin and the security review. Late or no-show results in you losing your shooting time and being charged the full price.

Can I cancel?

Later cancellation than 72h before the booked time can be charged full price Cancellation is only made by the cancellation code in the booking confirmation or by call. If you have made your booking through one of our authorized dealers, you must contact them directly when canceling and rebooking.

Can I use cash with you?

No, FMJ Shooting Range does not accept any cash, however, we take all cards (except amex) and swish. All bookings must be booked online and paid in advance. Group bookings made by companies are invoiced in advance.

How long does the activity take?

From your arrival time, **i.e. 30 minutes before the booked shooting time**, the activity takes a total of about 90–120 minutes. The time may vary depending on the event you have chosen.

Can my friends come along and watch?

Subject to availability, your friends are welcome to watch, otherwise they are welcome to wait in our Lounge and play pinball or arcade games in the meantime, as well as enjoy a steaming hot espresso.

Can I photograph or film my visit?

No for safety reasons, we have a photo and filmban inside the shooting range, however, we have a photo wall in our lounge where you are welcome to photograph yourself together with your target.

Who can't shoot?

People who are under the influence of alcohol or drugs cannot carry out the event, everyone shoots at their own risk, but we advise pregnant women not to shoot, as well as people who have problems with health or balance.

Can we share a shooting package?

Booked packages can only be used by one person

Is the room adapted for disabled people?

Absolutely, disability is not an obstacle at FMJ Shooting Range, we want everyone to be able to try their hand at shooting.

Is any special protective equipment needed?

Yes, before starting the shooting, the instructors provide you with hearing protection and goggles.

What is appropriate attire?

Untidy clothes, no large necklines and comfortable shoes.

Am I insured when I attend an event with you?

All Customers who participate in an event at FMJ Shooting Range will be insured for accidents at no extra cost in the event of any damage, loss or other inconvenience that may arise in connection with the experience itself.
